**Discussion**

- Taskforce reviewed a set of questions asked during the CIO conference.
- Co-chairs shared that the Chancellor's Office message is that their office will not be exploring or endorsing any changes to the SCFF within the next two years.
- Uncertain about whether this is the sentiment of the Legislature.
  - Are there any changes or improvements that essential and critical now?
    - ISAs?
  - Some movement is needed in some areas earlier.
